DAY FIVE – Sunday Cairo – Alexandria





DAY EIGHT – Wednesday Edfu – Kom Ombo – Aswan

After you enjoy a buffet breakfast on board the ship, you visit the Grego Roman Temple of Edfu by horse and buggy! The Temple of Edfu is the most complete temple in the world that dated back to the third century B.C. Return to the ship and cruise for 5 hours to Kom Ombo. You will visit the double temple of Kom-Ombo which was ddedicated to the Gods Sobek and Haroeris. Then return to the ship and sail to Aswan. Spend the night on board the cruise ship. Breakfast, lunch and dinner are included in the activities.

DAY NINE – Thursday Aswan
